Dear homeowner or occupier,

Following initial preparation works at Horsley Road, Effingham Junction, we will shortly be returning to continue our Surface Dressing 2025 Programme.

The work will take place Wednesday 30 July for 3 days – 9:30am to 4pm.

The road will be closed from the junction with Old Lane to outside the Bull Riding Farm.

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles to enable the work to proceed as planned.

The process of Surface Dressing is completed at separate stages and the road will need to be closed at each stage. New advanced warning signs will be placed on the road to notify you at each stage. Where appropriate, there can be several stages to these works:

- Stud (cat's eyes) removal
- Full Surface Dressing
- Waterproofing and sealing the Surface Dressing (LockChip)
- Stud (cat's eyes) replacement
- Lining

Please note, following works it can take a few weeks for the lining and studs to be replaced. All lining will be replaced like for like.


We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – they are keen to deliver the work with minimal disruption to you.

The work is weather dependant and can be delayed by bad weather or other factors. Please look at our information boards on site for date changes.
